Meet New MACRA Reporting Standards Through HASA

HASA needs your help with its MACRA Advisor Project (**MAP**), in support of the Medicare physician reporting requirements. If you plan to submit your Medicare quality and patient engagement measures to CMS and avoid penalties down the road, consider becoming a **MACRA Advisor**.

For the first 30 participants who join the MAP committee, HASA will waive its interface costs, provide support services at no cost for one year, and assist your practice in obtaining Medicare incentives and avoiding reimbursement penalties. MAP participants must be an eligible Medicare Provider, planning to submit data in 2017, and meet the below criteria:

- Contribute CCD (Continuity of Care Document) and 837 claims data from a certified EMR to HASA
- Provide feedback and quality controls for reporting
- Sign the HASA Letter of Engagement by Dec. 31st, 2016

Why submit to CMS with HASA instead of my EMR?

HASA is a non-profit community Health Information Exchange, a utility to facilitate secure patient information exchange. Participating in HASA improves your odds of avoiding CMS penalties and increasing reimbursement in years to come. It's a **no-cost, no-risk investment** in your practice, your financial health, and the community. Data contribution allows you to:

- Access patient information from multiple physician practices outside your EMR
- Get **shared CMS credit** for procedures that are performed elsewhere in your referral network
- Submit data for Quality, Clinical Practice Improvement Activities (CPIA), and Advancing Care Information (ACI) categories in one place
- Know in **real-time** if you are meeting your goals to improve your measures before it's time to submit
- Automatically qualify for specific MACRA objectives, including participation with an HIE
- Enable patient access to the community patient portal
- Utilize the HASA Services* free for one year.

*HASA Services include: HASAProviderAssist, HASAAlerts, MACRA Reporting and HASAGoAccount

MAP Phase 1

- Establish connectivity between HASA and your EMR
- Supply HASA with copies of your claims submission for additional MACRA reporting
- Test and validate HASA MACRA reporting tools and begin running quality reports in preparation for CMS submission
- Utilize HASA suite of services now to view hospital and community physician data, such as mammograms and A1C values
- Access real-time discharge notifications so you know right away when your patients seek emergency treatment or have been hospitalized
- Offer patients access to the community patient portal to see their shared community data in one convenient place



MAP Phase 2

- HASA will work through approval process to become a Qualified Registry
- HASA Care Coordination Tools available to all MAP Participants (including community referral network and outreach tools)
- Submit at least 90 days of Medicare required data for 2017 directly to CMS via HASA

Two Ways to Submit to HASA

- **CCDA Manual “drop”** - Basic interface to qualify for MAP, but less friendly workflow; typically no cost from the EMR side. (\$2700 value)
- **CCDA via IHE profile** - Integrate workflow into EMR for automatic community data availability (\$5000 value)
*EMR fees may apply and are the responsibility of individual practices *
- HASA fees waived for first year (\$300 per provider per year value)
